

SSVF – SUPPORTIVE SERVICES FOR VETERANS & THEIR FAMILIES

This program will assist very low income Veterans Families experiencing Homelessness to be HOUSED or Prevent Veterans Families to be Homeless.

SSVF – RAPID REHOUSING / PREVENTION Assistance Requirements:

- A veteran or a member of a family in which the head of household or the spouse is a Veteran.
- Household that is at 50% or below area median Income.
- Occupies permanent housing but at risk of becoming “literally” homeless.
- Is homeless & schedule to become a resident of permanent housing within 90 days.
- Has exited permanent housing within previous 90 days to seek other housing that is responsive to Veteran’s income capabilities, needs and preferences.

Clients will be required to provide the following documentations:

- 1) Copy of DD-214
- 2) Social Security cards for everyone in the household
- 3) Picture ID for all adults in the household
- 4) Military ID/VA Benefits card
- 5) Proof of Income (Veterans benefits/employment/disability/child support/TANF or any other Form of verifiable income.
- 6) Proof of Homeliness (Shelter referral)

SSVF – Prevention

All of the above and:

- 7) Copy of Lease (must state that if utilities are disconnected tenant will be evicted)
- 8) Bill in termination

Prior to assistance : An Housing Habitability Inspection must be performed

Remember : IF NOT BUT FOR OUR ASSISTANCE , VETERAN WILL BE HOMELESS.
